CASE STUDY

CHALLENGE

Professional guidelines recommend all teens have their first reproductive health visit between ages 11 and 15 years, with regular reproductive health visits throughout the adolescent years. Only half of adolescent females report discussing contraception with their healthcare provider and teens report waiting an average of 8 months after becoming sexually active to see a healthcare provider.

SOLUTION

Healthcare providers should provide reproductive health visits to adolescents on an annual and as needed basis. In order to learn how to do this effectively and efficiently, medical professionals need to participate in CREW.

RESULT

Due to their participation in CREW the health centers experienced:

- a **13% increase** in adolescent patient care visits
- an **increase of 498 visits** and **140 unique adolescent patients**
- **increased STD testing, pregnancy prevention**, and other “wrap around services” for their adolescent patients
